Abstract:

Component based software development has attracted considerable support in the software industry in the last couple of years. The notion of using highly reusable components in composing applications is thought to improve cost effectiveness and reduce time-to-market.

Java is found to have a number of favorable characteristics in supporting component technology. The talk will give an overview of using Java in component based development, and discuss several prominent Java based component models.

About the speaker:

Andrew Kwok-Fai Lui is an Assistant Professor at the Open University of Hong Kong. Andrew received a BSc in Computer Science from the University of Sydney in 1992 and a PhD from the Australian National University in 1998. His research interests include distributed systems, imagery systems, object oriented software frameworks, and web technologies.
