Abstract:

In this talk, Dr Tsang and his assistants will demonstrate two different approaches in building a dynamic website. The workshop will be conducted in two sessions. Session I hands on in building a flat-file Web-database. This type of web-database will be useful for small organisational website which has a limited budget. The second part of the workshop deals with using CodeCharge and MySQL to build a dynamic website. This technique to create dynamic relational database website will meet the demand of large enterprise. Seats are limited to ten participants to ensure maximum hands-on and interaction opportunity. Participants are expected to have knowledge in using ftp, designing simply web page and using simple Unix commands.

About the key speakers:

Dr. Tsang is a senior member of the IEEE and an honorary professor of the Fujian Radio and TV University, China. He has organised a number of International Web Conferences since 1994. Recently he was on the SCMP 2001 Web Competition expert panel.
